Hearing and Doing the Word - ESV

¹⁹ Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger; ²⁰ for the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God. ²¹ Therefore put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls. ²² But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. ²³ For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. ²⁴ For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like. ²⁵ But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres (continues in – NKJV), being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing. ESV

²⁶ If anyone thinks he is religious and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his heart, this person's religion is worthless. ²⁷ Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world.

Quick to Dear Slow to Speak Slow to Anger

The Progression Towards Evil Actions:

Bitterness – smoldering resentment

Anger – internal smoldering

Wrath/clamor – wild outrage; shout outcry,

public outburst.

Malice – general term for evil; root of all vices towards others.

Slander/strife – ongoing defamation from a bitter heart. Open conflict between parties.

Matthew 12:34 – "Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks."

Proverbs 10:21 – "The lips of the righteous feed many."

Proverbs 12:18: "the tongue of the wise brings healing.

Proverbs 12:6 "the mouth of the upright deliver men.

II. Wickedness Renounced; the Word of God Received – v21 Therefore, get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can save you. (James 1:21 NIV)

Lay aside:

- Taking the name of the Lord in vain.
- Trivializing Terrible Realities by saying: Holy cow, go to Hell, damn it, Holy mackerel, Jes.
- Referencing sex and the body in vulgar ways, the four-letter words.
- Speaking in mean spirited ways.

Now receive with humility the Word of God.

- Calvin: humility or meekness: "the mind disposed to learn."
- Christians are born again through an imperishable seed which is the word of God, I Peter 1:23.
- And the Word grows in you taking you from milk to meat. Hebrews 5:12

Saves our souls: Salvation is threefold:

- Past: received forgiveness of sins from the Lord.
- Future: complete salvation through our sanctification to our glorification.
- Present: Here the word save is present tense, that the word implanted saves our souls on a daily experience of what the Lord has done and is doing in our lives.
