## Election Selected Verses

Introduction: Review humanity's sin nature.

To understand election, I invite you to turn to Romans 8:29-30. This is called the 'Golden Chain of Salvation.' For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. <sup>30</sup> And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified, and those whom he justified he also glorified.

God, the Father, sovereignly elected or chose a number to His eternal covenant and to be conformed to the image of His Son. Ephesians 1:4-5, Mark 13:20, Acts 13:48, I Timothy 1:9, Romans 9:11-13, 15-16, Deuteronomy 7:1-11

**When did the foreknowing occur?** Ephesians 1:4, Revelation 13:8, 17:8, I Timothy 1:9

From our Roman 8 text, following foreknowledge comes predestination. John 15:16, 6:37, 64-65, Ephesians 1:5

Along with being foreknown and predestined, God grants faith as a gift and evidence of election. II Thessalonians 2:13-14, Philippians 1:29, Ephesians 2:8-9

**Evangelism is sure in election.** II Timothy 2:10, John 4:35

## The Takeaway: Jeremiah 1:5, Galatians 1:15

To recap, here are the questions I grappled with which I shared with you: 1. Who does the electing, God or man? 2. When did the electing take place, in eternity or in time? 3. On what basis was the electing, or choosing, done. Was it based on free grace or unconditional, or was it based on a condition of one's free will?
